



3. Travel to Korea

3.1. Passport & Visa

Participants who are traveling to Korea must have a valid passport and visa. Please do make sure that you have held a granted visa prior to your flight to Korea. For your visa assistant, please refer to the websites below;

All delegates are recommended to apply for the [Ordinary Tourists C-3-9] visa unless any individual is applicable for other possible visa.

3.2. K-ETA

Participants who can travel to Korea visa free does not need to apply for a visa but needs to register for the K-ETA online 72 hours before departing. Please check the link below.

3.3. Flight Tickets

E-Tickets will be sent to the participants individually based upon discussion with the secretariat. However, please do make sure that final flight schedule may differ from personal preference based upon an actual flight schedule and any other situation.

3.4. Negative PCR/RAT Test Results

A Negative Covid-19 test result is mandatory before boarding on the plane and entering the Republic of Korea. Please do prepare one of the followings, and the test result and method should be written in Korean or English.

- PCR Test result, which is issued within 48 hours prior to the departure date
- RAT (Rapid Antigen Test) result, which is issued within 24 hours prior to the departure date

3.5. Q-Code [MANDATORY]

Starting July 14, 2022, **all travelers must submit** post-entry test results on Q-Code regardless of Q-Code pre-entry registration.

Q-CODE is mandatory before entering the Republic of Korea. You will have to enter your personal information and other information required. Most importantly the negative result of the PCR or RAT test. Please make sure to check the website to prepare everything beforehand. Please check the following link for guidance.

3.6. How to Fill Out the Arrival Card

If you are arriving in Busan by plane, you will receive an arrival card from a flight attendant before your flight lands in Busan. You must have the card filled out in advance, and submit it for review at the immigration checkpoint, along with your passport and boarding pass. You are strongly advised to write all information required by the arrival card in legible capital letters without any spaces in between.

COVID-19 Regulations

4. COVID-19 Regulations

4.1. Before Arriving to Korea

Negative PCR or RAT test result in your home country is mandatory before heading to Korea.


In order to reimburse the COVID-19 test fee, please do make sure to submit the payment receipt to the Secretariat when arriving to Korea.

Please check the requirements for the entrance of your home country and let us know whether if you are required to take a COVID-19 test before departing from South Korea or any other issues so we can assist according to the needs.

4.2. After Arriving to Korea (Busan)

All travelers are required to take a PCR test within 1 day (before 23:59 of the next day) after arriving in South Korea.

- Test Center: COVID-19 test center, Kimhae (Busan) International Airport
- Location: Gate 1, 1 Floor, Kimhae (Busan) International Airport



The Secretariat will be at the arrival gate to guide each participant to the test center first. After the test, the participant who applied for the pick-up service on the registration form will be guided to the car. All payments will be made by the Secretariat.

For the participant who did not apply for pick-up service, it is mandatory to find the COVID-19 test center by himself / herself, which is located outside of Gate 1 at Kimhae (Busan) International Airport. After the test, it is recommended to take a local transportation (e.g., taxi) to get to the hotel and please do make sure that the participants can be released once get the negative result.

- Airport to Hotel: app. 45 minutes
- Fare: KRW 26,000 (app. USD 20)

Mobum (taxi in black color with yellow cap) taxi is more expensive due to its high-quality service, which causes the taxi fare to be three or four times higher than regular taxi (in orange, gray or yellow).

In case you are travelling alone from airport to the hotel, please do make sure to submit the receipts (taxi, COVID-19 test) to the Secretariat since the payment will be reimbursed based on the receipts.

4.3. After Arriving to Korea (Incheon)

Incheon Airport COVID-19 Testing Center

- Incheon Airport COVID-19 Testing Center provides COVID-19 test and issues certificate for inbound and outbound passengers.
- Incheon Airport manages 2 COVID-19 Testing Centers(East / West) at T1 and 2 COVID-19 Testing Center(East / West) at T2.
- Incheon Airport COVID-19 Testing Center offers following tests : ①RT-PCR
②Antigen/Antibody.
- Please select testing center and time at your convenience since all testing centers offers same type of tests at same price.
- You must bring your passport to take COVID-19 test and get certificate.

Travel from Incheon Int'l Airport to Asti Hotel

We recommend you to take a train.

Incheon Int'l Airport → Seoul Station (AREX) → Busan Station (KTX) → Asti Hotel Busan (Step 1) Incheon International Airport → Seoul Station (AREX)

You can take AREX (Airport Express) at the transportation center in Incheon International Airport on B1 floor. You will be able to buy a ticket from the information center or ticket machine. The fare is KRW 4,150.

(Step 2) Seoul Station → Busan Station (KTX)

You can purchase the KTX ticket to Busan Station (KTX) either online or at the ticket office on the 2nd or 3rd floor in Seoul Station. The ticket is issued for a particular departure time, train number and seat number.

(Step 3) Busan Station (KTX) → Asti Hotel Busan

It is a 3-minute of walk from Busan Train Station to Asti Hotel.

4.4. When Tested as Positive

If tested as positive in your home country, it is not permitted to enter into the Republic of Korea. If tested as positive after arriving to Korea, the person got infected will be quarantined for 7 days.

4.5. Insurance

Participants are also advised to get travel insurance, including COVID risks, at their own expense, following standard practice.

5. General Information

5.1. Weather in Busan (September)



The average annual temperature for autumn is 17.2°C. Except for the damage caused by typhoons, it tends to be sunny under the influence of the migratory anticyclones in autumn. When autumn comes, there are large differences in temperature between day and night. Rainfall will be more frequent in September than in August in Busan.

- Recommended outfit: Summer business casual

5.2. Currency

The unit of currency is Korean Won (KRW). USD 1 is approximately equivalent to KRW 1,327 (this may subject to change based on exchange rate).

The Korean currency is called the won (KRW). The coins in circulation include KRW 10 (embossed with an image of the Dabotap Tower), KRW 50 (embossed with an image of an ear of rice), KRW 100 (embossed with an image of Admiral Lee Sun-shin), and KRW 500 (embossed with an image of a crane). The Korean notes include the KRW 1,000 (blue), KRW 5,000 (brown), KRW 10,000 (green), and KRW 50,000 (dark yellow).

5.3. Recommended Sightseeing

5.3.1 Jagalchi Market (52 Jagalchi Haean-ro, Jung-gu, Busan)

Jagalchi Market is famous for the slogan, “Come, See, and Buy.” It is a place where you can feel the unique friendliness of Busan. A selected fish can be sliced on the spot for you to eat raw. Watching a flopping fish cleaned into sliced raw fish is in itself an amazing scene. Jagalchi Market is a must-see place for tourists.



5.3.2. BIFF Square, Busan (58-1 Gudeok-ro, Jung-gu, Busan)

In Nampodong, the “BIFF Plaza” is installed. Nampodong is one of the downtowns in Busan and is spacious enough to hold hundreds of people at once. During 2014 BIFF, a stage was set up in the heart of the “BIFF Plaza” for fans to meet movie directors and actors/actresses. However, this place is especially interesting for movie lovers because it has a movie theatre that was made for the first time in Busan, in 1934. The theatre has not been remodeled to appear more modern, so people could watch the newest films in the oldest theatre. Many people finds such history most captivating!



5.3.3. Yongdusan Park (37-55, Yongdusan-gil, Jung-gu, Busan)

The 120m high Busan Tower commands a particularly impressive view of Busan. It is also loved as a break area downtown where various programs and events are held each season. Please note that it can be easily reached by using the escalator leading to the park which was installed on Gwangbok-ro Street.



5.3.4. Lotte World Adventure Busan

Lotte World opened in OSIRIA Tourist Complex, Busan, on March 31, 2022. Lotte World Adventure Busan is decorated in warm orange tones, making you feel as if you are in a warm fairytale. Visitors can enjoy 17 rides, including Giant Digger and Giant Splash, various performances and events. As the anchor facility for the Osiria Tourism Complex, the city expects it will re-invigorate the Osiria Tourism Complex by attracting 20 million annual visitors.



5.3.5. Use the Busan City Tour Bus

- Loop Tour and Themed Tour Departure Point: In front of Busan Station Square (between Exit 8 of Busan Metro)
- How to buy a ticket
 - Loop Tour: A Day pass for the Loop tour can be purchased from the driver at the time of boarding at each stop (first-come-first-served)
 - Themed Tour: Reservations be required in advance. A themed tour ticket can be used only once, in a single service.
- Fares (in Korean Won) / Holidays
 - Adult 15,000won / Children (5 ~ HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT) 8,000won
 - Group Tour (15 people or more) 2,000won Discount per Person
 - ※ Holidays: No services on Mondays(Unless it is a public holiday)

Participants are welcome to visit the places after an official programme schedule is over. In this case, participants should come back to the hotel individually.

5.4.2. Recommended restaurant (near Asti hotel)

5.4.2.1. Pyeongsanok

Run by a family for four generations, this restaurant with a 100-year tradition is known for the steamed pork meats and noodles served with the soup from cooking meat. Made with fresh, domestic meat, the clear broth is nourishing and rich. The taste is nothing short of their longstanding history.

5.4.2.5. Donaenubyetjip Tongsamgyeop Galbi






6.3. USIM
